

Teacher's Notes Primary Cycle 1

Vowels: a, e, i, o, u

1. Session warm up

Introduce International Literacy Day using this video.

2. Phonics lesson

As a class, review the alphabet by singing the alphabet song. Then sing the alphabet song again but this time each student says a letter. The first one says "A", the next student continues with "B" and so on until the last letter. Identify consonants and vowels. The vowels are **a, e, i, o, u**. The rest of the letters are consonants.

Finally, review the pronunciation of common colours (red, blue, green, yellow, etc.) with the students. Repeat each colour word aloud, encouraging students to mimic your pronunciation.

Students complete the worksheet individually.
